On 22 December 2025, students and teachers of National Public School, Kengeri visited Desire Society, located on Bannerghatta Road.

Desire Society is an organisation dedicated to the welfare of disadvantaged children, with special emphasis on HIV-positive victims, those abandoned by one or both parents, dependents of sex workers and truck drivers, and individuals who have experienced abuse or severe socio-economic challenges.

The visit was organised as part of the school's commitment to social responsibility and community service. Students from Grades 8 to 12 actively participated in this initiative. Essential items such as groceries, biscuits, dry fruits, soaps, and detergents were contributed by the students to support the daily needs of the residents of the society. The visit of students along with five teaching faculties, provided meaningful exposure to social realities and helped instil values of empathy, compassion, cooperation, and civic responsibility among the students.

The experience was enriching for both students and teachers, reinforcing the importance of service, kindness, and social awareness, in line with the school's vision of holistic education.
