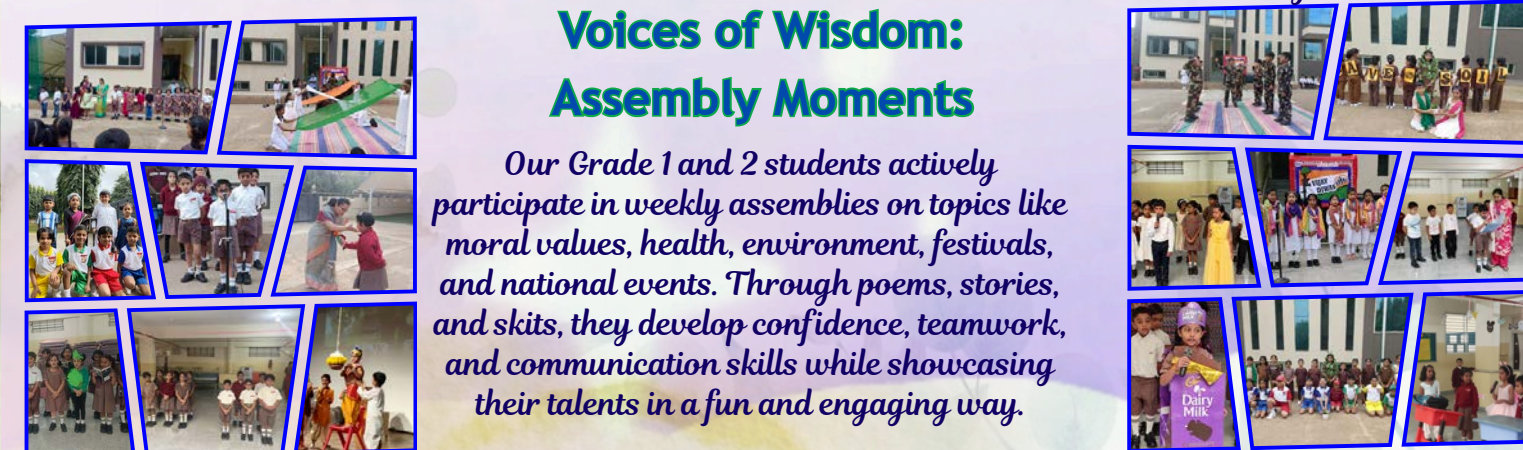
Joyful Christmas Celebrations on Campus

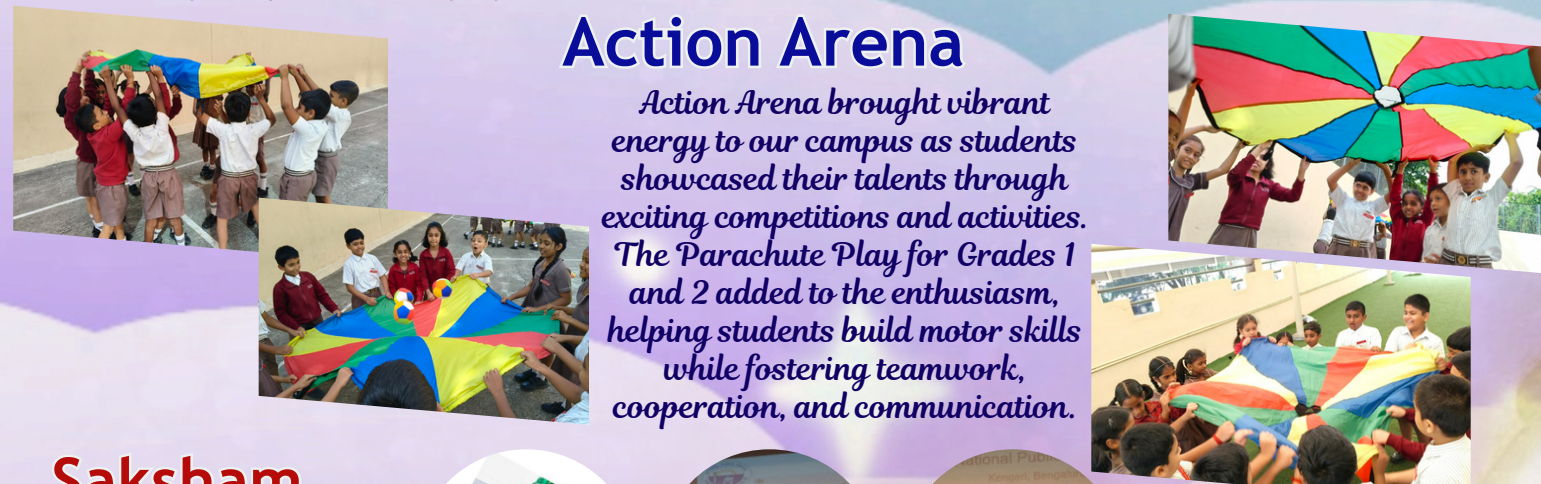
Crown Achievers-Celebrating Talent and Creativity
