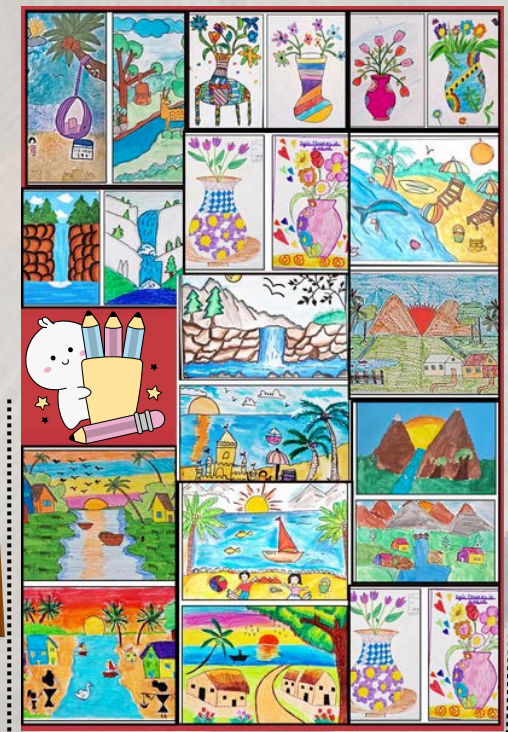
Creative Spark with Silver Foil
