An educational field trip was organized for the students of Classes IX to XII from 15 October 2025 to 17 October, 2025. A total of 59 students accompanied by seven teachers travelled in two AC buses to Puducherry and Mahabalipuram. After lunch, the students visited the Crocodile Park in Chennai, where they observed reptiles closely and witnessed a live demonstration of snake venom extraction.
