Report on Grade 11 & 12 Educational Trip

On 15th October 2025, the Commerce students of Grade 11 and 12 visited the HDFC Bank, Kengeri Branch, for an educational trip. The visit was organized to provide students with practical exposure to the functioning of a commercial bank and to help them understand various banking operations in real life.

The students were divided into two batches for the visit. The Branch Manager, Mr. Chelladurai Subramani, warmly welcomed the students and conducted an insightful session on daily cash transactions and how they are managed efficiently. He explained the process of preparing and issuing a Demand Draft (DD) and also demonstrated the clearing process of cheques. Students were shown the cash deposit section and the locker system, where he explained the security measures followed to ensure customers' safety and confidentiality.

Mr. Subramani also spoke about the number of branches HDFC Bank operates and how transactions are handled across branches on a regular basis. Furthermore, Mr. Vijay Kumar, the Cluster Manager, interacted with the students and spoke about career opportunities in the banking sector. He also provided a detailed explanation of mutual funds and their importance in financial planning. He encouraged students to open their own bank accounts to gain firsthand experience in money management and develop financial discipline.
