An educational trip educates students to learn in a practical & interesting manner. To provide such an opportunity for skill development and integration of new perspectives with informal environments and enhance learning initiatives, National Public School, Kengeri organized an educational trip to HAL Heritage Centre and Aerospace Museum, old airport road, Bangalore, for the students of Grades 6, on 16th August, 2019. The museum, spread across 4 acres of land, showcases the growth of aviation industry & HAL for 6 decades featuring photographs and aircraft models tracing the history of aviation & aeronautics. A guide explained in detail about the aircraft models on display & utility of parachute and g-suit.

In the museum, there are two major halls – one displaying the photographs charting the growth of aviation in each decade from 1940 till date. The second hall displays a motorized cross section of model of aero engines, highlighting various functions of the engines. The students saw the AV film documentary on HAL, its branches all over India, its jet fighter aircrafts & helicopters used as part of India's defense warfare. They eagerly took down notes on the details of various photographs and models of motorized aerospace engines on display. The students were left awestruck & spell bound on seeing some of the indigenous aircraft models designed by HAL.

The picture perfect place with beautiful garden, cafeteria with granite dining tables, the awesome huge aircraft models..... was a virtual wonderland for the students. They found their visit to the HAL Museum to be an enriching & electrifying experience. It surely enhanced their scope and depth of learning.
