Plant a tree. Plant a life.

For the children to have a better connection with Nature and also to understand the importance of Trees in our environment children of KG and Mont had a great time and hands on experience of Sowing seeds in their small pots and giving life to a plant.

The activity was planned on 10th July 2019, the enthusiastic tiny tots were divided into small groups and the teachers had planned the event with all the necessary supplies like seed planters, soil, gardening tools to fill the seed cups and water them.

The children took part in the activity by sprinkling the seeds carefully and thereby supporting the "GO GREEN" initiative. The teacher also engaged the other students with songs related to rain and nature.

Seed germination is a very important experiment for young kids as it helps them to learn about the origin of Fruits and Vegetables. They were fascinated to see the first sign of green pops, popping out from the seed like a tail and later they were kept on the window sill for the children to know about the essential requirements for a plant to grow. The concept of non-circulating hydroponics which they have been learning was used to plant the saplings without the use of soil.

After few days the children took their pots home with the caption "see me grow" on the Popsicle stick. It was an eventual day and the activity prompted the young minds to open up their wings of creativity.
