REPORT ON SEWA 2022-23

Social Empowerment through Work and Action (SEWA)

SEWA activities comprises raising community awareness regarding health, sanitation, civic habits and environment, unpaid teaching and assistance in teaching, volunteering in nursing homes, orphanages, public events and assistance, care for senior citizens of our community, environmental activities like clean-ups, recycling, wildlife preservation societies, partaking in health, wellness and sanitation camps, participate in aiding fund raisers and any trivial act for the wellbeing of our society.

The students' council members of NPS Kengeri organized a donation drive for stationery items for an orphanage as a part of SEWA project. The drive was a great success, with more donations than expected. As a result, the students were able to give to two different orphanages.

The donation drive was open to students of grade 6 to 12. The students were encouraged to donate new and unused stationery items, such as pencils, pens, notebooks, erasers etc. The students collected the donations in a central location in the school, and the drive lasted for three days from 17th November to 19th November 2022. The response was overwhelming, with many students donating multiple items.

*After the donation drive was completed, the students sorted the stationery items and delivered them to two different orphanages. The first orphanage was **Sneha Jyothi Charitable Trust**, which is located in Kumbalgudu. The second orphanage was **Parivarthan India Foundation**, which is located in Vrushabavathi Nagara, Kanakapura main road. The students delivered the stationery items to the orphanages on 20th January and 11th February 2023.*

The donations were received with great gratitude by the children at both orphanages. The donations had a significant impact on the orphanages. The staff at both orphanages reported that the stationery items were greatly needed and would be put to good use. The children at the orphanages were excited to receive new stationery items, which they could use for their schoolwork and creative pursuits.

The donation drive organized at NPS Kengeri was a great success. The students of NPS Kengeri should be commended for their generosity and community spirit.
