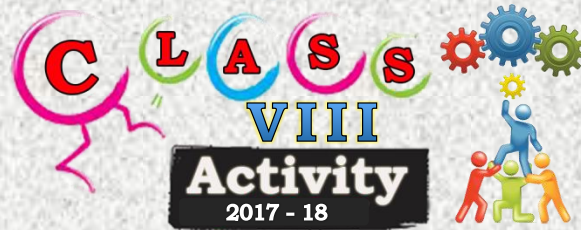

The theme for the Class Activity Presented by the students of Grade 8 was:

## **“MAKE IN INDIA”**

The programme began with short address to welcome the gathering, which was followed by a satirical group song on the economic status of the country. The song was laced with humour on the financial condition of the people and also took a dig at politicians and ended with the question – How to come out of the difficult situation that we find ourselves in, as a country?

With that, the theme was introduced, the initiative and history behind it, and the difference between “MAKE in India” and “MADE in India” was also emphasized. The students presented information on how increasing the production of various items within India itself can contribute to the revenue of our country and also if common man is aware of the same, then significant economic progress can be achieved. The names of a few Fortune-500 companies that have contributed to the success of the initiative and their achievements were also highlighted.

The students then presented skits which emphasized the need for “Make in India” and also reflected the views of the layperson. Hidden within the skits were also information about India’s prowess in the manufacturing and scientific sectors which, when used in the correct way, could quite considerably enhance the country’s revenue and make good use of the abundant human resource.

One of the manufacturing sectors, i.e. Textiles, was taken as an example to model the uses and variety of different textiles that can be manufactured in India due to easy availability of resources, thus employing more people and boosting the Per capita income of the country, with the support of both Governmental and Non-governmental agencies.
