NPS, Kengeri organized an educational trip for the students of Grade VI – VIII to AIR (All India Radio) station, Bengaluru on 21st August 2017.

The objectives for the educational trip was to understand and uphold the unity of the country and promote national integration, enlighten education entertainment and enrichment, awaken and inform, through the broadcast.

Students commenced from school at 8:30 am and reached the AIR station, Bengaluru by 10:30 am They were welcomed by the AIR staff who voluntarily took initiative to explain how the channel is being broadcasted, the transmission takes place, the place of the main tower and the area it covers to broadcast its frequencies, how the songs are played and lined up in the desktop, the job profile of announcer, artists, different rooms allotted for recordings, music, news, interviews department and so on. Lastly they took children to the heart of the AIR, where hard disks were kept. Also they showed students the room where previous recording work are kept and stored. The queries asked by students related to frequencies, hard disk and about the source of income were clearly explained by the AIR staff volunteer. They also asked interested students to sing, mimic for first-hand experience of recording and play the old piano gifted by the late Mysore king in 1954.

Next students embarked their journey towards Gandhi Bhawan where the life of Gandhiji was displayed through photographs vividly. Later they showed the video clip in the auditorium which children thoroughly enjoyed and learnt the value and initiative started by Gandhiji to enhance vocational training and skill in India.
